OSB (Oriented Strand Board)

Rigid and dimensionally stable. Cuts and nails easily and approved for exterior sheathing.



Tongue & Groove Softwoods

Perfect for decking, floors or roofs. Sanded and unsanded.



Siding Plywoods

Available in a variety of sizes, thicknesses and grooved every 8 inches to simulate the appearance of individual boards. These sheets offer the look of wood siding with the convenient installation of plywood.

Melamine

One of the most practical surfaces around. Prefinished and ready for use. Great for cabinetry, wall units, closet organizers and more. White is always in stock and for something unusual, other colours & patterns are also available by special order.



MDF (Medium Density Fiberboard)

Intended for interior, non-structural projects like counter tops, etc. Very smooth surface paints and machines well.

MDF Super Lite

1/3 lighter than regular MDF. Maintains excellent strength, surface smoothness and stability.



MDO (Medium Density Overlay)

A natural for painting. The surface is entirely smooth and grain free. Available in #1 and off grades.

Sanded Softwood

Our sanded softwood plywood is available in thicknesses ranging from 1/4" to 1" or metric equivalents. 4' x 8' sheets are standard however some items are available in larger sheet sizes. Panels are finished and sanded on one or both sides depending on the item. These general-purpose sheets are great for shelving, utility cabinets and other projects not requiring the appearance of our hardwood cabinet grade panels.



Pegboard

Pegboard hardboard is a hardboard which is pre-drilled with evenly spaced holes. The holes are used to accept pegs or hooks to support various items, such as tools in a workshop.



Slotwall

Alternative to pegboard, ideal for workshops or retail display areas. The 3" on center grooves run the length of the sheets, either the 8' or 4' direction. Comes in many colours as well as unfinished MDF, which also accept standard pegboard hooks and accessories.
